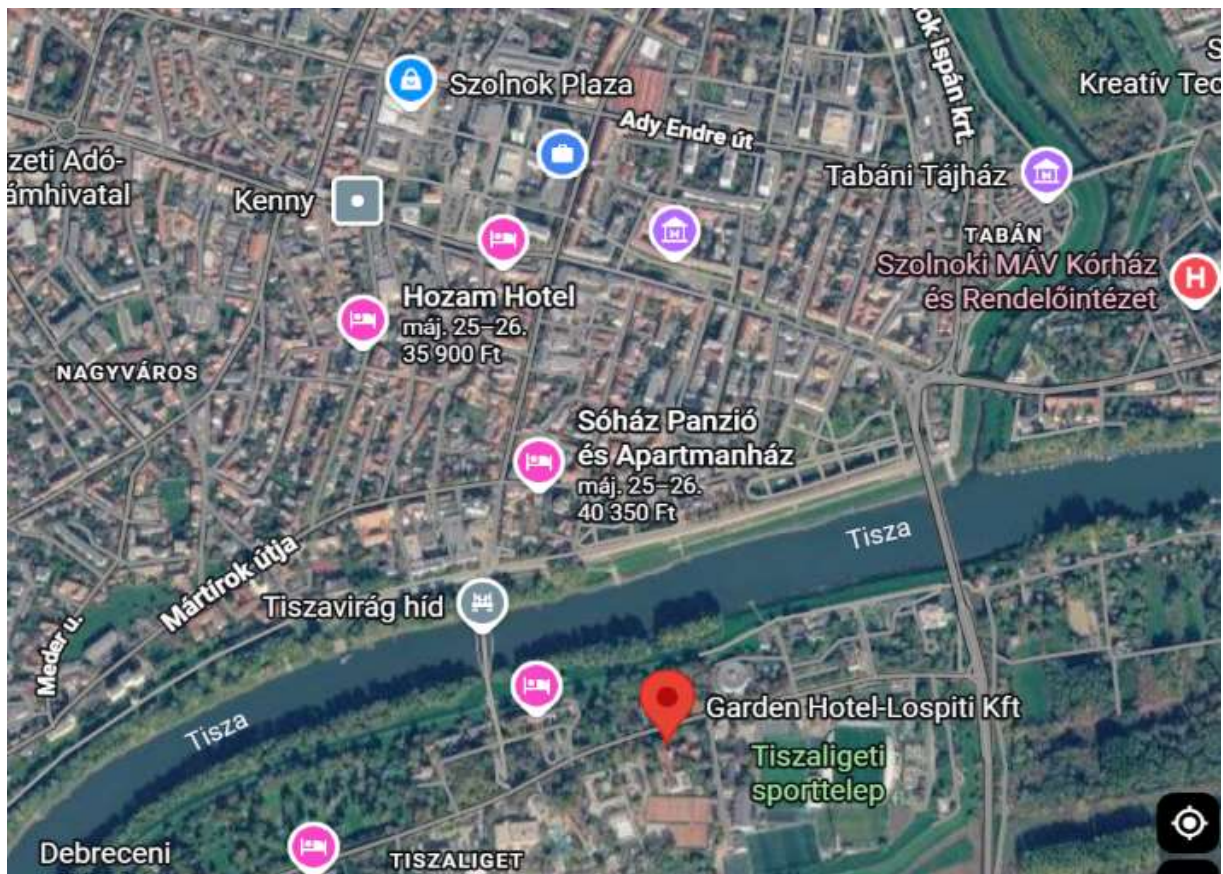

<b>10:00</b>	<p><b>Visit of Mezőtúr wastewater treatment plant and SW solutions</b></p> <p>The <b>Mezőtúr wastewater treatment plant</b> has undergone significant modernization through major projects supported by EU funds and the Hungarian State, transforming it into a high-capacity, environmentally friendly facility. Key Technological Upgrades:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Capacity Expansion:</b> The plant's hydraulic capacity was tripled from the original 900 m<sup>3</sup>/day to a robust 2,700 m<sup>3</sup>/day, allowing it to handle the city's increased load safely.</li> <li>• <b>Organica Technology:</b> One of the most advanced features is the implementation of Organica reactors. This biological treatment method uses specialized plant root systems and microorganisms to break down pollutants, resulting in a more aesthetic, greenhouse-like facility with minimal odor.</li> <li>• <b>Modern Sludge Management:</b> New sludge presses were installed to dehydrate waste. This process significantly reduces the volume of sewage sludge, making transport and potential agricultural reuse more efficient and cost-effective.</li> <li>• <b>Mechanical Pre-treatment:</b> The upgrade included new automated screens and grit chambers (sand traps) to ensure that solid waste and abrasive materials are removed before the water reaches the biological treatment stage.</li> </ul>
