Introduction


On 10-11 June the official in person Kick-off meeting of the project "D-CLEAN - Improving Water Quality in the Danube River Basin: Nature-Based Solutions for Sustainable Wastewater and Stormwater Management in Small Settlements" funded under the Danube Transnational Program will take place in Vienna, Austria hosted by the International Association of Water Service Companies in the Danube Region (IAWD).

The meeting's objectives include (1) the in person get together of the ten project partners, (2) the deep dive into the three Specific Objectives including planning related work and (3) the overall context setting for the project including the engagement of the Associated Strategic Partners.

The Kick-off meeting will start on 10 June in the morning and conclude on 11 June in the afternoon after a fieldtrip to Seestadt Aspern, a new city quarter of Vienna, in which a <u>large-scale</u> <u>rainwater management system</u> based on the dual infiltration model has been installed for the first time in the "Lakeside Crescent Quarter".

Although in person attendance is highly recommended, online attendance is also possible.
