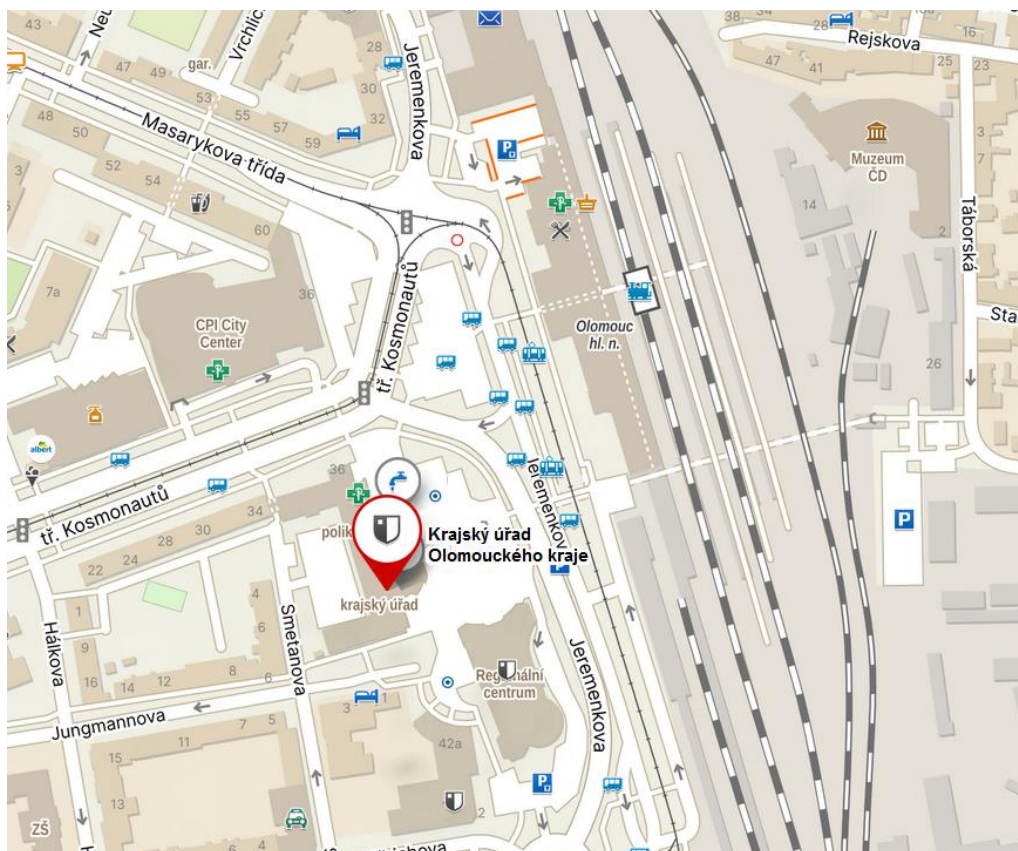

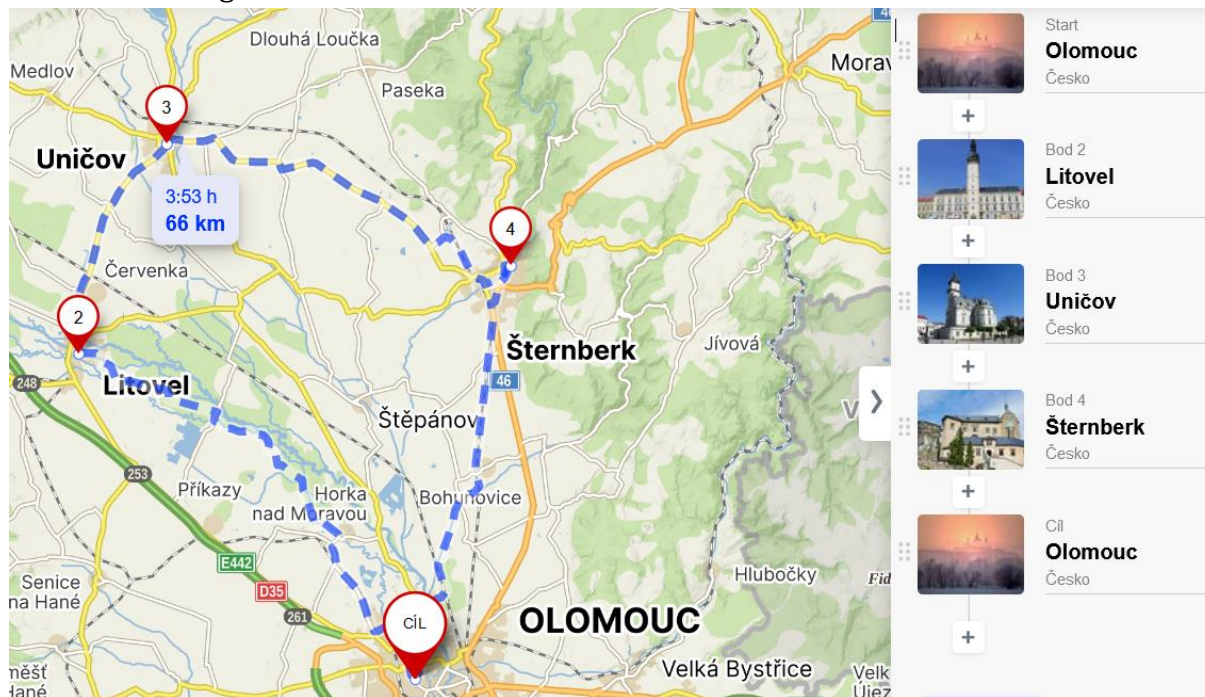

Bike tour through the towns of Olomouc - Litovel - Uničov - Šternberk – Olomouc



The cycling excursion aims to introduce:

- 1) The financing principles of cycle trails in the Czech Republic**, specifically in the Olomouc Region and on our bike circuit. We will present the Czech national project CYKLOVIZE2030. The aim is to create a safe transport network for cyclists, which is good news for drivers too, as each cycle path will take cyclists off busy roads.
- 2) The principles of intermodality in practice**, and at the PT stops and stations on our bike circuit. This is especially good news for people who travel by public transport. Cycle paths will get them safely to where they need to get.
- 3) Experiences.** The cycling infrastructure is mainly used by locals on their daily journeys to work, school, shopping etc. When having a day off, they like to just ride. The photos were taken on May 1, 2024, which is a Czech holiday. It's great to see so many families with children using this circuit. Well, but you are tourists, so we want to prepare an unusual experience that you will remember. We won't be chasing mileage, but enjoying the route. We will discuss the basic facts about points 1 and 2 at the working meetings on 16-17 July, and on 18 July we will verify the information in practice.
