Background

Objective: To strengthen capacity in the planning and implementation of local development policy, identification of key issues, analysis of challenges, and development of solutions, as well as the formulation of proposals concerning the development of green infrastructure at the level of the territorial communities of the Dolyna subregion (FUA).

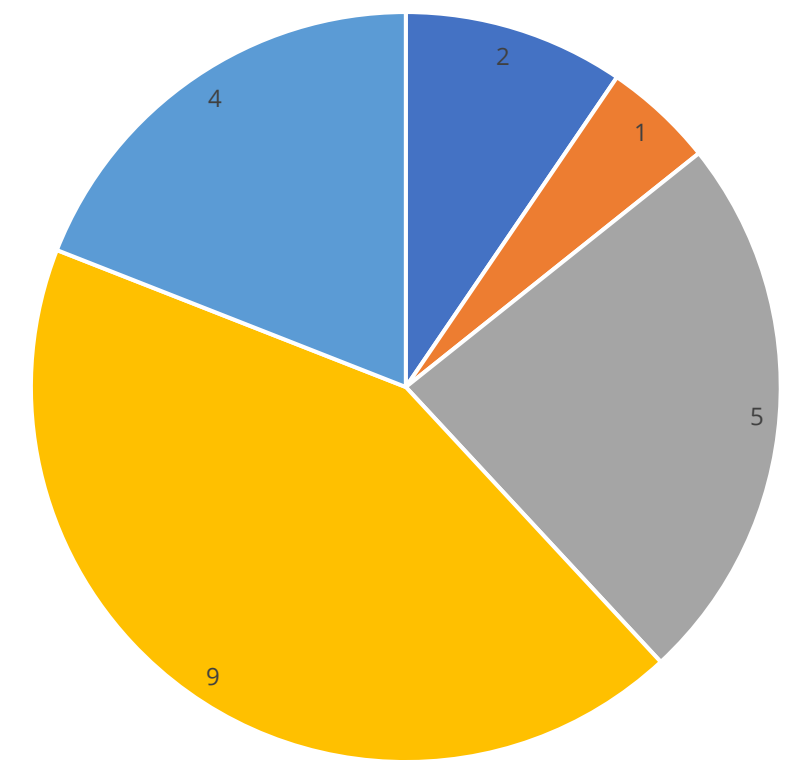


METHODS USED IN THE WORKSHOP



Key survey results

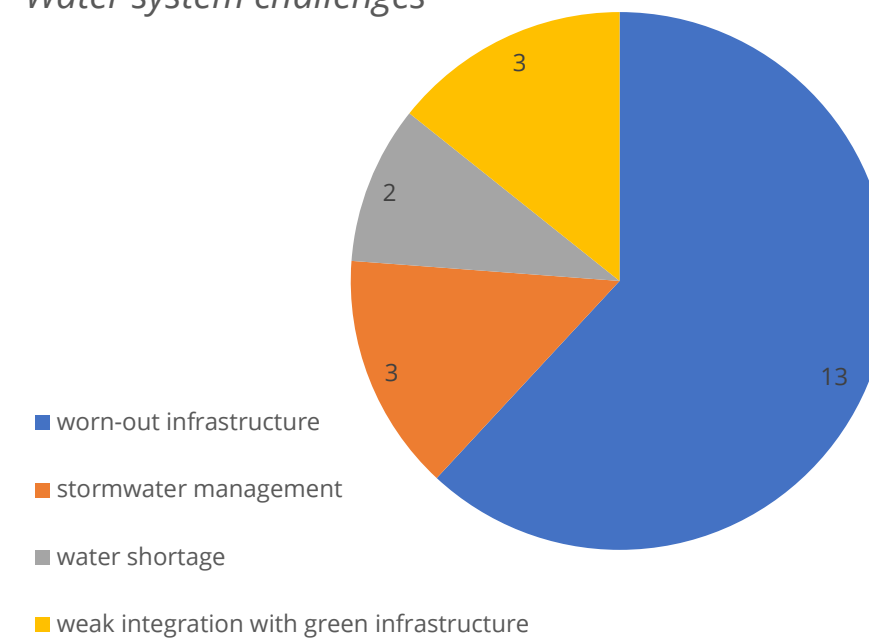
State of water supply and wastewater sewerage in the TC

NEXT STEPS

Analyzing the interrelationships between the SWOT factors.

Conducting the second workshop, during which priorities in the field of green infrastructure are identified.

Conducting the third workshop, during which 2–3 alternative project proposals aimed at improving water supply and wastewater management conditions are developed.

Development Strategy of the Dolyna Subregion 2027

- Representatives of 30 neighboring settlements were involved
- Development strategy was developed
- Prioritization was developed which was merged into one administrative entity
- Priorities are being implemented
