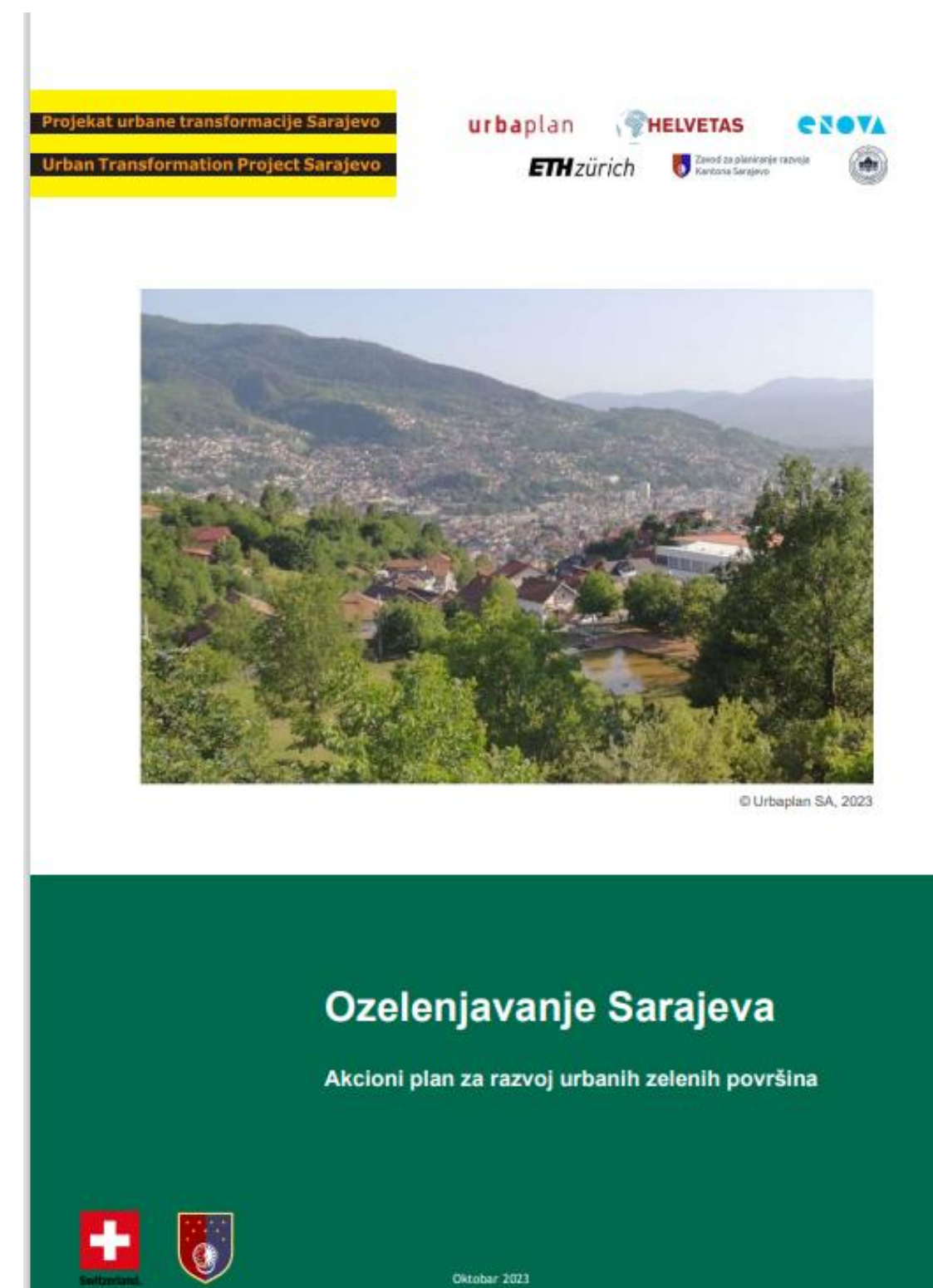
# The Action Plan for Development of green urban areas in Sarajevo

## MAIN OBJECTIVES

The main objective of the Action Plan for the Development of Green Urban Areas in Sarajevo is to expand, improve, and sustainably manage green urban spaces in Sarajevo in order to enhance environmental quality, support climate resilience, and improve the health and well-being of citizens. This includes increasing vegetation cover, integrating green infrastructure into urban planning, reducing air pollution and heat effects, and promoting community engagement in maintaining and protecting green areas.

## Key Results and Achievements

Expanding and improving urban greenery through large-scale tree planting, park creation and revitalization, and the integration of green infrastructure such as green roofs and rain gardens. It promotes sustainable landscaping using native species, supports community gardens and citizen-led initiatives, and uses GIS-based mapping to prioritize greening efforts. The plan also emphasizes public awareness and education to strengthen environmental responsibility and long-term urban sustainability.

The participacija.ba portal was developed as part of the **UTPS – Urban Transformation Project Sarajevo**.

The UTPS project is a four-year initiative financed by the Swiss State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO), **aimed at supporting the modernization of the integrated urban planning system in Sarajevo Canton and creating better conditions for sustainable socioeconomic development resilient to climate change.**

The project is particularly significant given the importance and necessity of adopting a new, integrative and participatory approach to urban planning—one capable of addressing climate change challenges while fostering more inclusive socioeconomic growth. 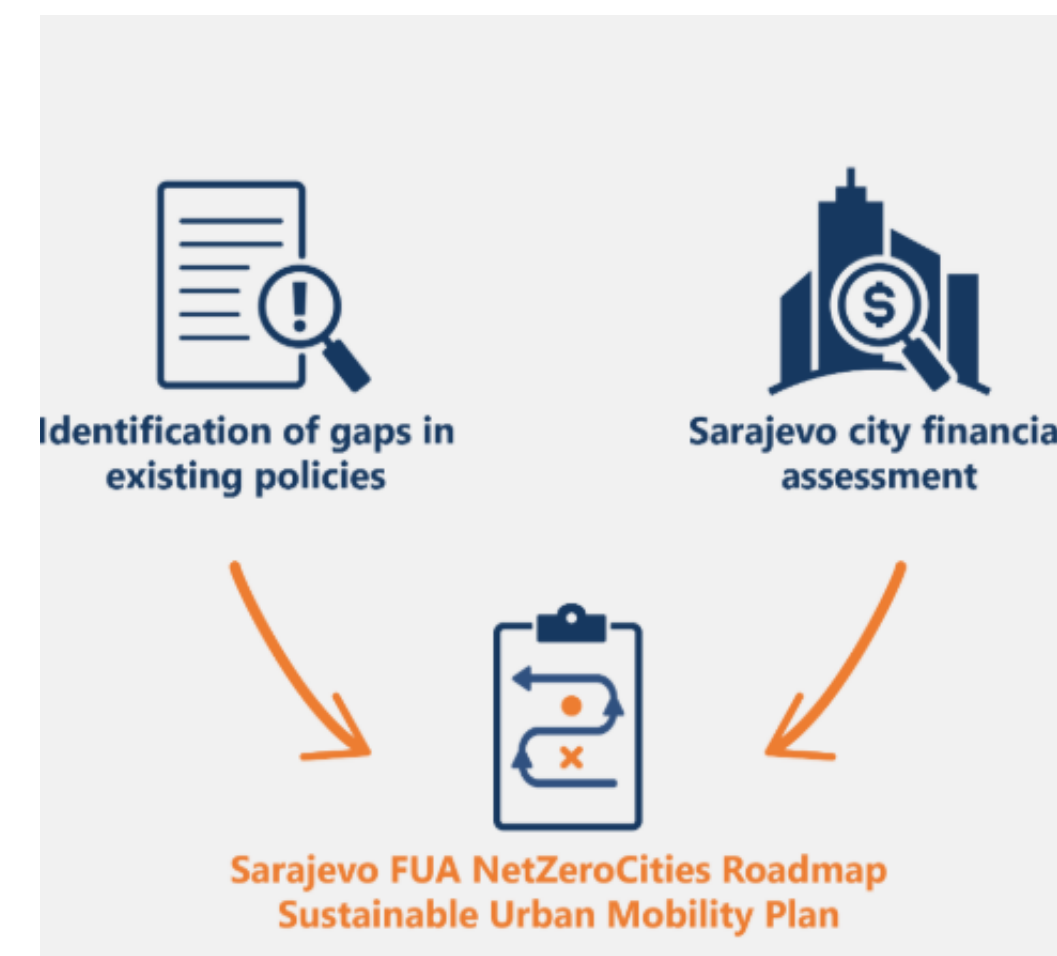
## Net Zero Mission Sarajevo Functional Urban Area (FUA) programme
